



The facility has gone two weeks now without any further COVID-19 cases with residents. We currently have four residents in isolation that have not been released by Public Health. Unfortunately, one staff member did come back as positive today from our last tests. That employee remains in isolation at home. We plan to continue testing all residents and staff twice weekly and expect all staff to wear their personal protective equipment.

We continue to report our numbers and any new cases to the local, State and Federal agencies. It appears that almost all facilities in the area are seeing an increase of positive COVID-19 cases and eighty-three nursing facilities in the State are in outbreak status. Those numbers can be monitored on the Iowa Department of Public Health's website.

CDC and the Public Health agencies have asked us to prepare for the delivery of a vaccination within the next few weeks. Flu vaccinations have been given to residents and staff. The next two months will be interesting for everyone. We also wish to thank all the residents, their families and government agencies for their support. We will keep you updated with any changes.
