Vista Wood's continues to be transparent and wants to keep our residents, and other concerned individuals, informed of our COVID-19 status. Today a resident who was previously exposed by a visitor tested positive and has been moved to our isolation area. That resident has been quarantined since the exposure became known. An employee without symptoms also tested positive. Both individuals were fully vaccinated and one was boosted known as breakthrough cases.

The facility also remains in contact with Public Health for any updated guidance. We have been informed that the county positivity rate is over 23% and one-third of the cases are now Omicron which is expected to spread rapidly now. All of our residents are vaccinated and almost all staff are fully, or partially, vaccinated. As you can see, this does not prevent us from getting COVID but has proven to reduce symptoms and hospitalizations.

We ask that all staff and visitors remain diligent in wearing the appropriate protective equipment (masks, face shields, etc.) and sanitize hands frequently. Everyone must also screen in prior to entering the facility. If needed, facility staff will assist you with that process and assess those who fail the screen-in process. Residents also have the right to deny visitors. All visitors should be respectful to residents by socially distancing.
