With continued transparency the facility reports that a resident tested positive today for COVID-19 and has been moved to our isolation area. There are now two residents in that unit. Both residents were previously quarantined as newly or readmitted residents. Facility staff are required to wear the appropriate personal protective equipment and use good infection control practices. They are also required to be screened prior to entering the facility. Both staff and residents have also been tested twice weekly. Today, all residents and staff, who agreed, received the COVID-19 vaccination. This was step two for most of those individuals.

The facility continues to report any COVID-19 case to various public health authorities and follows various guidelines from the CDC, CMS, local and State public health agencies. With all the measures above, we hope to contain further spread of the virus.
