Our facility reports that three more residents and one staff tested positive for COVID-19 today during routine surveillance testing and now the facility is in an outbreak status. This makes five residents in-house in isolation and one in the hospital. One staff and one contract employee remain at home in isolation. All cases have been reported to local and State public health officials and their recommendations are being followed. All the individuals identified above have had their COVID-19 vaccinations but perhaps they have not taken full effect at this point. All residents are monitored daily and staff are screened prior to working their shifts. Both residents and staff are being tested twice per week. The pandemic has been frustrating for all of us and we sincerely appreciate your on-going support.
