Vista Woods remains transparent with any COVID-19 status changes within the facility and the community. During routine testing this morning, an employee tested positive. That employee has not worked in the facility for the past several days but did work this AM for a brief period in one area of the facility. The employee did not have any signs or symptoms of illness. We hope this is a single isolated incident however the facility will be taking precautions by testing all staff twice a week for two weeks and all residents in one wing once per week for two weeks.

Staff have been required to wear additional protective equipment, including face shields, for the past two weeks because of the high COVID-19 positivity rate in our county. Everyone entering the building must be screened in and should not visit if they have any cold-like symptoms.

Our facility works closely with Wapello County Public Health and who offers us various recommendations. We also post updates on the facility's website www.vistawoodscarecenter.com. It is important for all of us to be careful out in the community, especially attending larger events. Keeping a mask and hand sanitizer available is our best prevention.
