Vista Woods remains transparent with any COVID-19 status changes within the facility and community. Today, an employee tested positive for COVID-19 in the community. That individual did not have any known contact with residents. We will continue to test all residents and staff twice weekly for the next two weeks.

The community transmission level for COVID-19 remains high in Wapello County.

The FDA has just authorized a new COVID-19 vaccination. This new vaccination is more like the Flu shot which is bi-valent vaccination that will provide an immunized response that is broadly effective against COVID-19 and components in common with the omicron variants BA.4 and BA.5.

Vista Woods, in conjunction with NuCara Pharmacy, will be holding a vaccine clinic for both the new COVID-19 and Flu shots on September 28 at 9:00 A.M. Families will be called for consents to receive the vaccines. We encourage all staff to participate also. It is recommended to get the new COVID-19 vaccine two months after a previous Covid vaccine or having COVID.
