Our current status remains with two residents with active COVID-19 cases. They are isolated in a separate area until released by the physician and public health.

We continue to strive to protect both the residents and staff from this virus. Staff continue to be required to wear the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), use good hand hygiene and encouraged to use social distancing. We are in constant contact with both the Wapello County and Iowa State Public Health agencies, following the guidelines from CMS and Department of Inspection and Appeals. We, like all other facilities, report daily to various State and Federal agencies with daily status reports.

The facility is preparing to receive vaccinations for COVID-19 in the upcoming months. We have recently given the Flu vaccination to both residents and staff.
